

Capacity:	Ceremony: 300 Reception Hall: 150 Parking: 75
Music:	Organ and Grand Piano A musician can be booked through Christ First or you can bring your own
Photographs:	There is a large lawn for outdoor photo's. The sanctuary has stained glass windows on both sides
Extra Rooms:	Extra rooms can be booked for family use before the ceremony

Both locations have an elevator and accessible washroom.


## Port Credit Campus

Address:	151 Lakeshore Rd W, Mississauga, ON L5H 1G3
Capacity:	Ceremony: 300, including a balcony area Reception Hall: 150 Parking: 20 plus street parking
Music:	Organ and Grand Piano A musician can be booked through Christ First or you can bring your own
Photographs:	Local parks are nearby for photos
Extra Rooms:	None available

Both locations have an elevator and accessible washroom.

## Off Site Weddings

At their discretion, our Lead Minister is available to perform your wedding ceremony at an offsite location of your choice. Extra fees will apply for travel.



#### Other Information

Rehearsal	Booking one of our locations includes a one hour rehearsal before the wedding date. Attendees for the rehearsal will be the wedding party, officiant, musician and administrator. Recorded music must be organized during the rehearsal.
Legal Document	You must have a marriage license, in order to get married. You can pick up one from any town or city hall in Ontario. It is valid for 90 days from the date of issue. Please deliver the license to the church 2 weeks before the wedding and we can ensure the appropriate parts are filled out before the ceremony.
Music	We welcome couples' input on personal music selections they would like. Contemporary and secular music is welcomed as long as sheet music is available. For onsite weddings, our organist/pianist will meet with you to choose music. Requests can be played on the organ or piano. They can also accompany soloists and make general music suggestions.
Photography and Video	During the service, only the designated photographer is welcome to take non-flash pictures with consultation with the minister. Personal photographers will be asked to not disrupt the service. Video-taping is permitted as long as the videographer consults the minister about location during the service.

#### Other Information

Décor	Wedding Day – Timing of flower deliveries and decorating the sanctuary must be discussed with the administrator at the time of booking. Throwing of rice, petals or confetti inside the building or on the property is strictly prohibited.
Program	If you require a printed wedding program, you can work with our administrator to create a special memory of your day. Extra costs will apply.
Reception	Tables and chairs are on site or can be rented. Liquor license must be obtained. Caterer can use large kitchen to plate and serve food. All dishes, glasses and linens must be rented.

How many people can this location accommodate?	300 including guests and wedding party
What is the ceremony rental fee and what's included in that price?	<ul> <li>Ceremony \$1,450         includes sanctuary, minister, musician,         administrator, custodian         <ul> <li>Reception \$ 1000                 includes auditorium, kitchen, tables, chairs, host, custodian</li> </ul> </li> </ul>

How many hours does the rental fee include, and is there an overtime fee if I stay longer?	Four hours are booked for decorating, the ceremony and removal of decorations. Extra time is \$100 per hour.
How much is the deposit, when is it due, and is it refundable?	Deposit of \$200 is required at time of booking. It is refundable up to 30 days before the booked date.
What's the payment plan for the entire bill? What forms of payment do you accept?	Remaining balance due 14 days prior to the wedding date. We accept cheque or e-transfer.

Can I have my reception here, too? What is the additional cost?	Yes. Speak with our administrator about extra costs.
Are there changing areas for the bride, groom, and/or wedding party?	Yes, separate rooms must be booked at initial consultation. Extra fees apply.
Can we provide our own music (live musician or recorded)?	Yes. Arrangements must be made at time of booking. Recorded music equipment and setup must be worked out at rehearsal.

Can we have our rehearsal dinner here?	Yes, separate rooms must be booked at initial consultation. Extra fees apply.
How much time is allocated for the rehearsal?	One hour
What's the cancellation policy?	Deposit is refundable up to 30 days prior to the booked date. Remaining balance is due 14 days prior to the date. 50% of the remaining balance is refundable up to 7 days before the date.
